## What is the Social Equity Lens Investment (SELI) Coding System?

The Government of Canada launched the pilot SELI Coding System to help address systemic biases and inequities within financial systems and to expand opportunities for equity-deserving groups, reinforcing its broader commitment to social equity, gender equality, and Indigenous reconciliation through social finance investments.

The SELI Coding System assesses and tracks the progress of Social Finance Intermediaries (SFIs) and Social Purpose Organizations (SPOs) toward targets relating to equitable leadership, organizational culture, and portfolio/mission alignment. The criteria are available at the [Social Finance Fund \(SFF\) Hub](#). The Government is funding an initiative to provide support to SFIs and SPOs under the Social Finance Fund to advance their social equity and gender equality practices, which will be provided by Kore Global.

## What support is available?

- Learning resources including case studies, FAQs, and other guidance materials, in order to increase knowledge on assessing and applying social equity and gender equality practices broadly, and the SELI Coding System specifically. These will be available on the Kore Global website and on the [SFF Hub](#).
- Webinars on specific topics in social equity and gender equality organized in collaboration with Impact Frontiers (for SFIs) and LIFT Impact Partners (for SPOs), to learn from specialists and peers.
